

**Larchmont Model Yacht Club
2012 Spring Invitational Race
April 13-14, 2012**

Notice of Race

The Larchmont Model Yacht Club invites you to participate in our twelfth Spring Invitational Regatta to be held at the Larchmont Yacht Club in Larchmont, New York on Saturday, April 13-14, 2012.

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing and the rules of the CR-914 class, except as any noted in section 1.2 and by this notice.
- 1.2 The RRS and class rules are amended as follows:
 - (a) Rule 31: Boats may hit marks of the course without penalty.
 - (b) Rule E3.5: The starting sequence will be either thirty or sixty seconds long at the discretion of the Race Committee.
 - (c) Rule E4.5(b) is amended to read: While ashore or at the water's edge, boats may be adjusted, drained of water or repaired, have entangled objects removed, or have radio equipment or batteries repaired or changed. Boats will not be allowed to change, reef or un-reef sails during the regatta.
 - (d) Rule E 5.3: A boat intending to submit a protest shall inform the Race Committee immediately after completing the relevant race.
- 1.3 Class rule 4.6 is modified to read: primary winches shall be installed. Winches may be modified to avoid fouling sheets. Bow foot rails, steering wheels and non-functional winches are not required.
- 1.4 Class rule 8, requiring all boats to have a class-approved bow bumper, shall be strictly observed. No boat missing a class-approved bow bumper will be permitted to race.
- 1.5 In case of conflict between Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall govern. This changes RRS 63.7

4. Eligibility

The regatta will be sailed in CR-914 class sloops. All boats sailed must be registered with the CR-914 Class.

5. Registration

All participants must pre-register for this Regatta by completing the attached Entry Form or entering using the LYC on-line Registration at [www.LYC.org/Entries .]

Entries may be submitted via e-mail to dgraves@gravesite.ws, for receipt **no later than April 2, 2012**. Each entry must be accompanied by credit card payment instructions or Larchmont Yacht Club audit number of the entry fee of \$55.00. Any entry received after this date will be subject to a \$10.00 late fee. Registrations cancelled after March 30th, 2011 will be subject to a \$25.00 cancellation fee.

This entry fee covers Saturday’s Continental breakfast and lunch. Guests attending the event can participate in all event meals at a charge of \$20.00.00 per person.

It is the intention of the Committee for this regatta to be limited to 48 participants. All entries received on or before April 2nd will be deemed to have been received on the same day. All entries received after that date will be accepted based on date of receipt.

6. On-site Check-in

Check-in will be Friday afternoon between 1:00 and 4:00 pm. Committee members will be on-hand preparing for the Regatta and sailors traveling from out of town can register and participate in informal practice races. All participants must have checked-in by 9:15 Saturday morning.

Upon arriving at the Club for check-in, each sailor will report immediately to the Check-in Desk. All boats will receive a visual inspection and will be weighted with the batteries to be used when racing.

7. Friday Night Social Event -

At 7:00PM Friday night the 13th, there will be a buffet supper in the Junior Club House. This social event is not included within the scope of the regatta fee and is optional at an additional cost of \$35.00 per person.

8. Frequency assignment

Participants are encouraged to sail with 2.4 GHz frequency self-selecting radios. Participants using FM or AM radio systems will indicate their preferred and alternative channels on the entry form and will be notified upon receipt of entry form of their channel assignment for the regatta. LMYC will not provide any crystals for participants' radios and receivers.

9. Housing

The Larchmont Yacht Club has nine guest rooms and participants may rent available rooms by calling the Club at 914-834-2440. When making a reservation, please indicate you will be participating in the Larchmont Model Yacht Club Spring Regatta. Lodging is also available in area hotels including:

10. Boat Yard/Battery Charging

Boats may be stored overnight in the Club. During the day, tables will be set-up on the Veranda with ample electrical outlets for connecting recharging units. It is the individual skipper's responsibility to insure he or she has proper batteries. The Committee will not provide any spare batteries.

11. Hospitality and Guest Privileges

The Larchmont Yacht Club is extending the privileges of the Club to all visiting sailors while they are participating in the Regatta. Visiting sailors may purchase drink tickets at the Club's front desk.

12. Inclement Weather

It is the Committee's intention to race if it rains. All competitors are responsible for providing their own foul weather gear and covers for radios. Larchmont can be chilly in April; competitors are advised to bring warm sailing clothes.

13. Conduct and Responsibility

The skipper/owner shall be responsible for all actions of himself/herself and guests. In the event of a breach of conduct, sportsmanship, destruction of property, or failure to comply with the request of any race officer, committee member or agent of the Larchmont Yacht Club, the skipper/owner will be held responsible and his/her boat shall be subject to protest and disqualification.

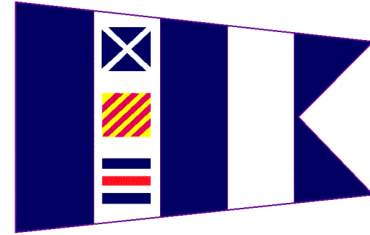

Responsibility for evaluating the wind, sea and weather conditions rests with each participant as does responsibility for the safe condition of the boat, including safety equipment and rigging and for deciding when to wear life jackets. Patrol boats or other assistance will not always be available. Assistance, if any, from the regatta committee or other Larchmont Yacht Club vessels, or other patrol boats, from any personnel manning them, is entirely at the risk of the participant.
